The TN Department of Economic and Community Development (TDEC) is writing a "State Digital Opportunity Plan." The plan will support new state programs that will help with digital skills, literacy, inclusion, and affordability. This can include:

all the fun we've had!






















### Looking to help support the CCA program?














## **Employment Services**

The Employment Services
department wrapped up another successful
Pre-ETS school year! In the 2022-2023 school
year, the ES Pre-ETS program expanded from 9
schools in 4 counties to 12 schools in 6 counties.
The program added schools in Hickman and
Marshall counties and added middle schools in
Lincoln County. The Pre-ETS summer program
started at the end of May and is currently
serving students in Bedford, Lincoln,
Giles, and Hickman counties.

The Employment Services department attended the Tennessee Disability MegaConference in May. The ES team joined self-advocates, families, and support workers from all over the state to discuss disability rights, services, and inclusion.

### A Little Bit of History...

Did you know that the Senior Equipment Loan Program is the sixth and most recently established of the Community Development Center's programs? Established in 2017, the Senior Equipment Loan program initially received its funding from a grant of the Community Foundation of Middle Tennessee. Since its inception, over 230 pieces of equipment have been loaned out to individuals in 10 South Central Tennessee counties.
